St. Michael's 175 Years as a Parish – "A Moment in Time"

Fr. William Pappano died in an automobile accident on Easter Sunday afternoon, April 19, 1987. His funeral liturgy was held at St. Michael, Archbishop Edward T. O'Meara as the principle celebrant. The Archbishop was joined by many of Fr. Pappano's brother priests. Fr. Pappano was laid to rest at his home parish in Richmond, In. Fr. Pappano was succeeded by his close friend, Fr. Bernard Koopman, a native of Starlight, In. Lucy Johnson had been hired as Director of Religious Education in 1985 and served in this capacity until her retirement in 1989. The parish hired Sr. Rose Karen Johnson as Director of Religious Education in 1990.
